School Reorganization Some of you may be aware that we have a substantial waitlist for students who want to go from in-person to virtual learning. Students on the waitlist will move to the virtual school on Monday, November 16th. The DDSB has directed us to close 3 classes when these students transition to their new school. Families who are affected by this reorganization have already been informed. The reorganization will be completed by the end of this week so students can start in their new class on Monday, November 16th. **Diabetes Awareness Month** Did you know that November is Diabetes Awareness Month? There are two main types of diabetes. Type 2 is the most common and can usually be controlled by diet and exercise. Type I diabetes accounts for approximately 5-10% of the diabetes population and is an auto-immune disease that strikes without warning at any age. Without multiple daily injections of insulin (needed for blood sugar regulation) those living with type I diabetes would not survive. The Charles H. Best Diabetes Centre is a charitable healthcare centre currently supporting over 375 children and 1,800 adults by providing them with essential type I diabetes education and care.




Thanks to all families who made a contribution. We collected close to 900 items that we were able to donate to Settlement House. Thanks again!!
